Background/aim: This set of instructions is in the style and format to be used by authors preparing abstracts for ICBP 2004. Please follow this example and these instructions when typing your abstract.

Methods: The abstract must be prepared in Microsoft Word; version Word 95, Word 97, Word 2000 or Word 2002. The abstract should be written in English and should be single-spaced throughout. The abstract should be written with type face Times and the font size should be 12. Maximum one (*I*) pages, including figures and tables, size A4 (i.e. 210 x 297 mm) with 2.5 cm margins on all four sides.

Results: The abstract should be headed by the title, author(s), affiliation(s) and address(es). The abstract should also contain address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address to the corresponding author. Underline the name of the presenting author. Begin the text two lines below the last line of the author/affiliation section.

Conclusions: References should be listed as below

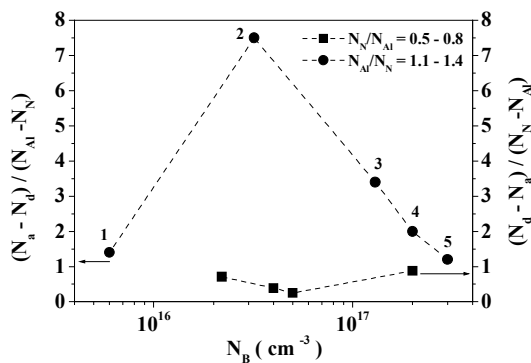


Fig. 1. The ratio of net acceptor concentration ($N_a - N_d$) to concentration difference ($N_{AI} - N_N$) vs. boron concentration (N_B) for the samples with N_{AI}/N_N between 1.1 and 1.4 (●). The ratio of net donor concentration ($N_d - N_a$) to concentration difference ($N_N - N_{AI}$) vs. N_B for the samples with N_{AI}/N_N between 0.5 and 0.8 (■)
